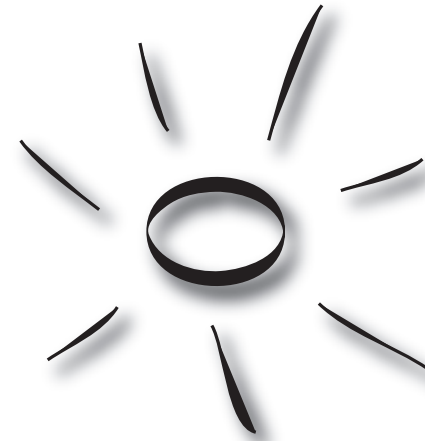

DEAR MALVERN CHALLENGER

Congratulations on entering the Malvern Challenge, we are sure you will have a very enjoyable weekend. Please read all the information carefully. Due to Football World Cup some alterations have been made to the usual program. If you have any problems see your Leader or contact the organisers.

FRIDAY NIGHT

Once you arrive your Leader will come straight to Control from 6pm and book you in for the weekend while you put up your tents. This is when your Leader will need your completed camp permission forms, they will also need to know which challenge you wish to enter on Saturday, either the Malvern or Cotswold challenge. The Cotswold challenge is targeted at older Scouts, Guides, Explorer Scouts and Guide Senior Section. Note only Scouts/Guides can win the MC Overall Winners Trophy. Once your Leader has booked you in, you will spend the rest of the evening in the Entertainment Zone (The Barn) where this year we have Entertainers, Dancers, DJs etc. This year due to the World Cup on Saturday we will also be holding heats for the Talent Show. Throughout the evening we will be serving soup and a roll. Please ensure that when you hit the pit you keep the noise levels down. You should be in your own tent!

SATURDAY

Breakfast will be served from 7:15am. You can start queuing when instructed over the PA, remember there will be over 3,500 to be served so please be patient. The start times of the Malvern & Cotswold Challenges are 9:30am - 11:00am. We have two starts to allow checkpoints to open longer and avoid queues. You will need to collect your packed lunch before you leave the site. Don't forget to take a drink with you. It will be very hot and sunny this year!

The Challenges: The emphasis of the Challenges is towards Patrol participation and working together utilising your Scout / Guide knowledge. We are often judging the whole Patrol not just a few individuals. There are 8 checkpoints that you must reach in the order shown on your route card, which each Patrol Leader will be given on Saturday morning. When you arrive at each checkpoint show them your route card and undertake the checkpoint activity. Make sure that the Patrol's route card is collected before leaving the checkpoint. Then make your way to the next checkpoint. Don't worry if you do not manage to get around all the checkpoints because of time limitations, this is taken into account when awarding marks.

Evening Entertainment: It starts at 4pm. with a wide variety of sporting activities / challenges, including the now famous MC Sport competitions: Tug of War – Football - Netball - Volleyball. We also have a bungee trampoline, human table top football and Superstars competition. For those less energetic there will be entertainment in the Barn including the Talent Show heats, with the first prizes being worth £75 for each category. (If you and/or your Patrol would like to enter the Talent Competition your Leader has an entry form). It all hots up at 7:30pm with the Football World Cup (if England win their group!) a cabaret of entertainment including the Talent show finals finishing at 11pm with an exciting nighttime Fire Act.

SUNDAY

Presentations: These take place first thing Sunday morning. Certificates will NOT be forwarded after the event.
Fayre: The theme for the rest of the day is a Fayre which runs till 2.30pm. All participants will be given MC money to spend. This will enable you to do a large variety of activities, including: crafts; competitions; skill tests; games; etc. There will also be arena events to watch, and some interesting entertainers. Along with Euro Bungee we also have some high thrill fairground rides to really test your nerves. Some activities will give prizes or items to take away.

RULES

Sorry but we have to have a few rules to ensure that we can all enjoy the weekend and live in harmony - but the most important rule of all is enjoy yourself!

GENERAL

1. All participants must be members of the Scout or Guide Sections of the movement, Explorer Scouts or Guide Senior Section members under 16 years old on the date of the Challenge.
2. No music after 11:00pm in the camping area.
3. No noise after 11:30pm in the camping area.
4. Camping area to be kept clean & tidy at all times.
5. No open fires or barbecues.
6. Access limited to camping area, car parks and barns, all other areas prohibited.
7. No vehicles on camping area.
8. Throughout the weekend Scouting and Guiding standards are to be maintained.

CHALLENGE RULES

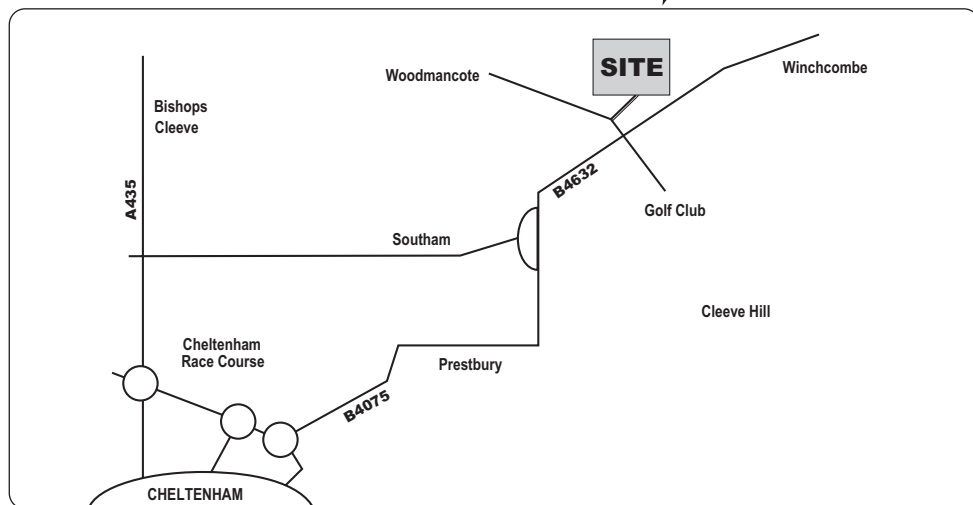
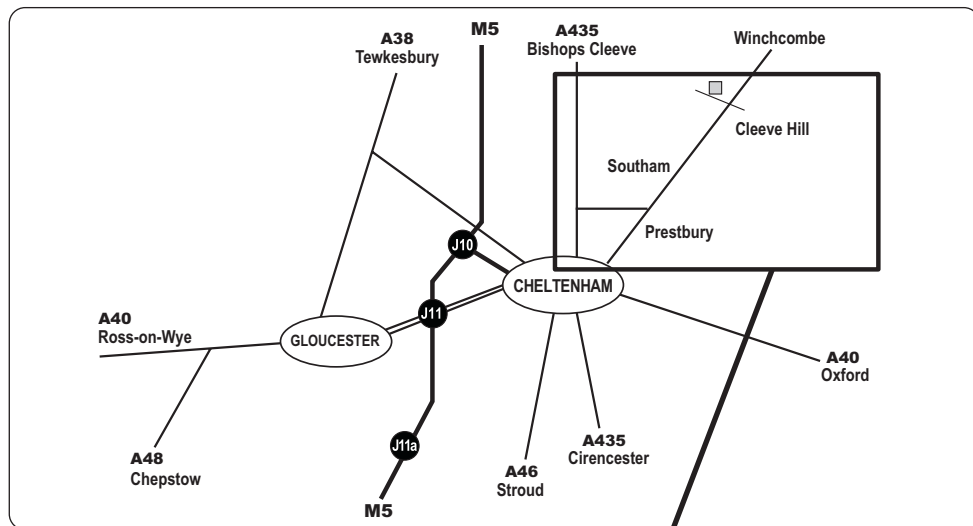
1. Patrols must consist of at least three and no more than six. If numbers are reduced to fewer than three at any point in the Challenge, then the remaining members must accompany another Patrol. Patrols must remain together at all times.
2. All items in the Kit List must be carried or worn at all times. Spot checks can be made at any point during the Challenge.
3. Patrols must walk in single file on roads and observe the Highway and Country codes.
4. Patrols must go through checkpoints in sequential order and start at the checkpoint indicated on the route card they are handed
5. Noise levels must be kept to a minimum at all times.
6. Participants needing to retire MUST DO SO ONLY AT CHECKPOINTS unless injured!
7. At the Finish time indicated on your Route Card all participants must make their way back to the main campsite, whether you have been to all the checkpoints on your route card or not. All participants MUST REPORT TO THE FINISH CHECKPOINT where points will be awarded for handing in your litter from the packed lunch.

Failure to comply with any of the above rules will result in the organiser taking appropriate action. This may result in disqualification from the Challenges or in extreme circumstances the home contact being called to collect the individual or members concerned.
